

VerifyX is committed to protecting your privacy. You can visit most pages on our site without giving us any information about yourself. But sometimes we do need information to provide services that you request, and this privacy statement explains data collection and use in those situations.

We will ask you when we need information that identifies you (personal information) or allows us to contact you. Generally, this information is requested when you are registering for access to our site, requesting services or purchasing products. Personal information means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, email address, a home, business, postal or other physical address, or other information, when needed to provide a service you requested.

When you browse our website, you do so anonymously unless you have registered and logged into our website. We do not log your IP address or link your IP address to any personal information unless you have logged into our website. Like many other commercial websites, the VerifyX website may use a standard technology called a "cookie" to collect information about how you use the site.

VerifyX collects personal information when you register for an account or when you use certain VerifyX products or services. From time to time, VerifyX receives personal information from business partners and vendors. VerifyX only uses such information if it has been collected in accordance with acceptable privacy practices consistent with this Policy and applicable laws.

Access to certain VerifyX web pages requires a login and a password. The use of those web pages, and the information or programs downloadable from those sites, may be governed by a written agreement between your employer and VerifyX. Unless you request deletion of your personal information as specified below, your personal information may be retained by VerifyX to verify compliance with the agreement, log software licenses granted, to track software downloaded from those pages, or track usage of other applications available on those pages.

When personal information is collected, we will inform you at the point of collection the purpose for the collection. VerifyX will not transfer your personal information to third parties without your consent. Your personal information is never shared outside VerifyX without your permission, except under conditions explained below. Inside VerifyX, data is stored in controlled servers with limited access.

VerifyX may send personal information to other companies or people under any of the following circumstances: when we have your consent to share the information; we need to share your information to provide the product or service you have requested; we need to send the information to companies who work on our behalf to provide a product or service to you (we will only provide those companies the information they need to deliver the service, and they are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose); or we want to keep you up to date on the latest product announcements, software updates, etc. We will also disclose your personal information if required to do so by law, to enforce our Terms of Use, or in urgent circumstances, to protect personal safety, the public or our websites.

If you are a registered VerifyX user, you can review your personal information by accessing your account. You may also request deletion of your VerifyX account or any of your personal information held by us by contacting our customer support.

Your VerifyX account information is password-protected for your privacy and security. VerifyX safeguards the security of the data you send us with physical, electronic, and managerial procedures. In certain areas of our websites, VerifyX uses industry-standard SSL-encryption to enhance the security of data transmissions. While we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure the security of the information you transmit to us, and so we urge you to take every precaution to protect your personal data when you are on the Internet. Change your passwords often, use a combination of letters and numbers, and make sure you use a secure browser.

Our website may contain links to websites operated by other companies. VerifyX does not share your personal information with those websites and is not responsible for their privacy practices. Although we choose our business partners carefully, VerifyX is not responsible for the privacy practices of web sites operated by third parties that are linked to our site. Once you have left our website, you should check the applicable privacy policy of the third party website to determine how they will handle any information they collect from you.

VerifyX will amend this policy from time to time. If we make any substantial changes in the way we use your personal information we will make that information available by posting a notice on this site.
